

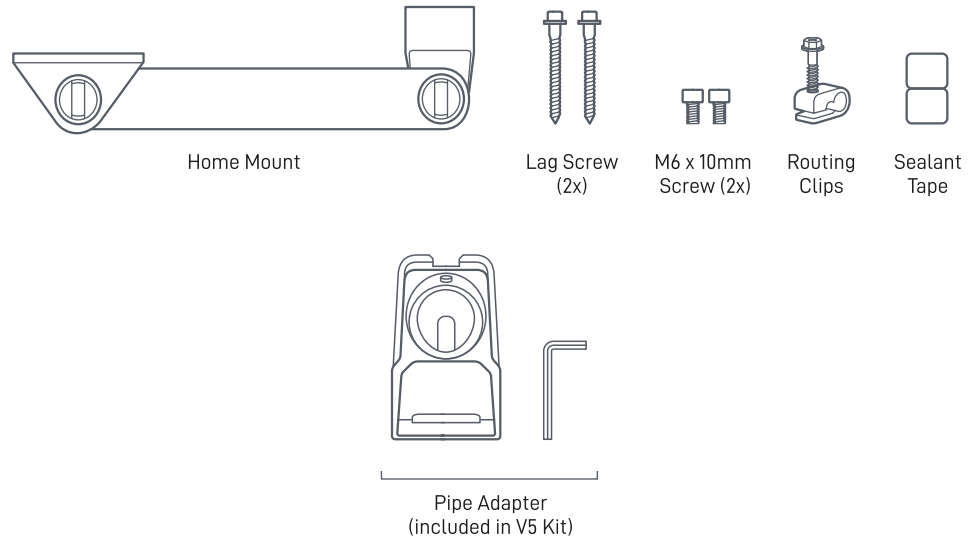

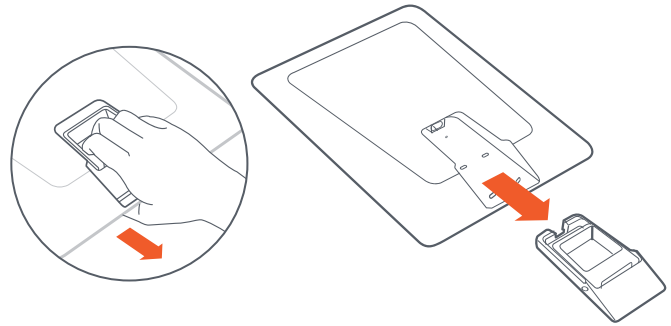

Remove Kickstand

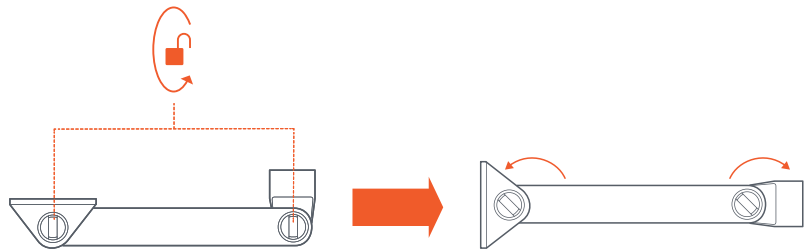
Remove the kickstand by pulling on the release tab.

Open Home Mount

Loosen the two thumbscrews on the Home Mount and move the joints into the open position. Having the Home Mount fully opened helps make the subsequent cable routing steps easier.



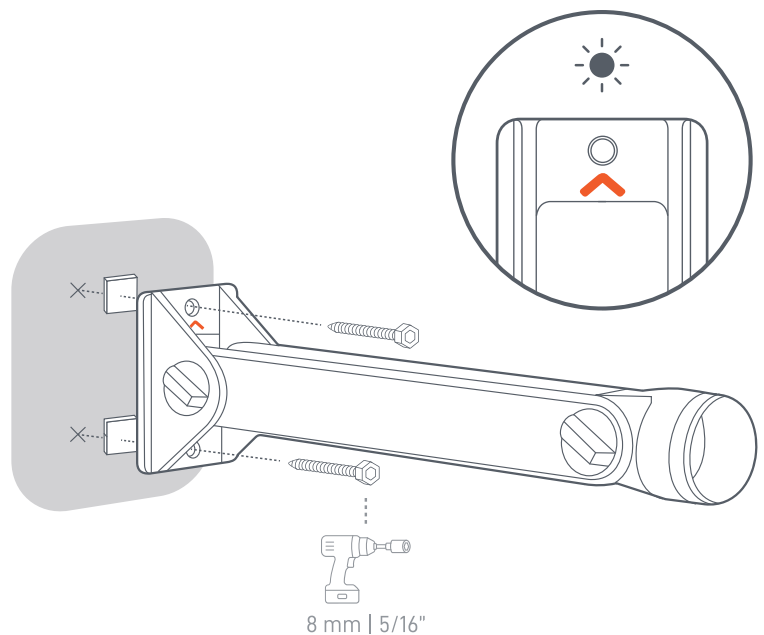

Install Home Mount

Determine the best location for your Home Mount. Note that the Home Mount can be mounted to vertical, sloped, or flat surfaces to enable a wide variety of mounting locations. Use the Obstruction Tool in the Starlink App to ensure your chosen location has a clear view of the sky that is free from obstructions.

Once a location is chosen, position the base of the Home Mount so that the mounting holes are vertically above each other and mark the hole locations. Place the provided Sealant Tape over the marked location.

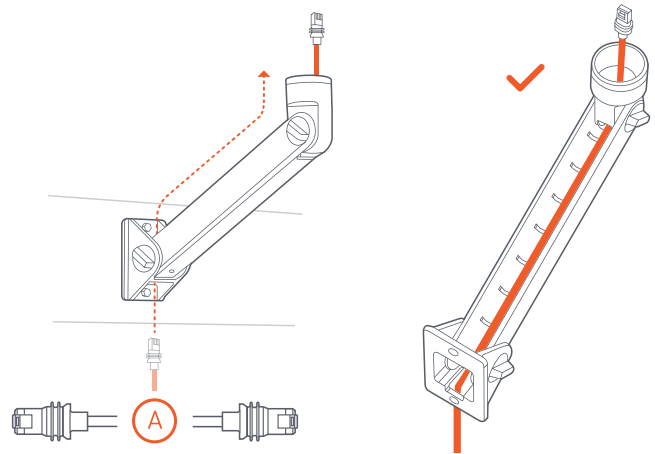
Place the Home Mount base back into position, ensuring that the arrow on the Home Mount base is pointing upward. Use the provided screws to secure the Home Mount into position. Note that the screws provided are self-tapping, so drilling pilot holes is optional.



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Route Cable

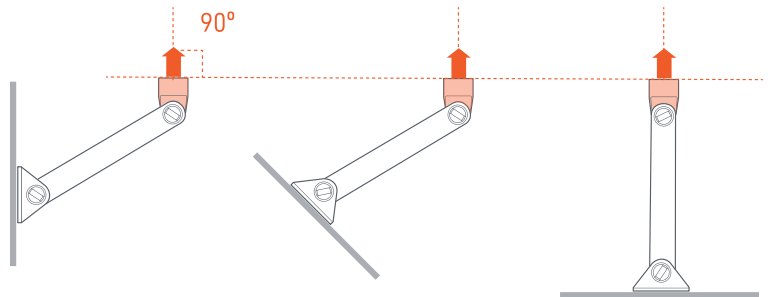
Route the Starlink Cable through the base of the Home Mount, along the arm, and up through the cylindrical end cap.



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Position Mount

Position the mount such that the top cylindrical end cap is horizontal (level to the ground). Having the end cap in this orientation helps ensure that your Starlink is able to be properly aligned.

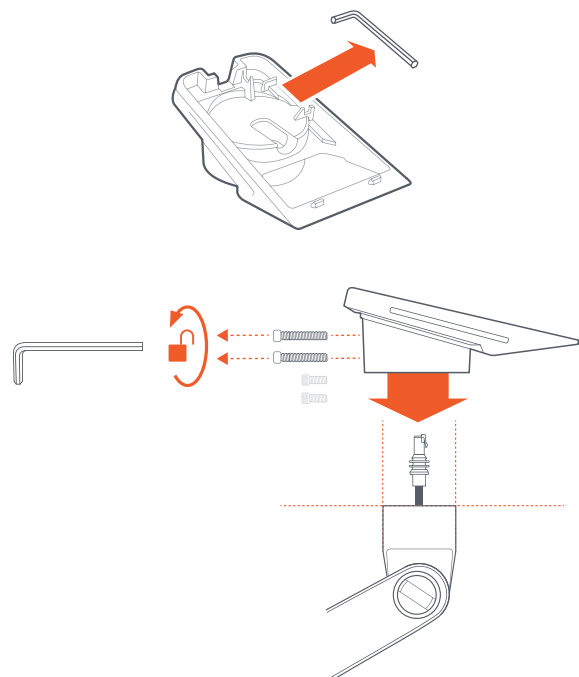


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Install Pipe Adapter

Locate the Pipe Adapter that was included with your Starlink Kit. Pull upward on the Hex Key to remove it from the storage location on the Pipe Adapter. Remove the two Securing Bolts that were pre-installed in the Pipe Adapter using the hex key.

Route the Starlink Cable through the hole in the Pipe Adapter, then slide the Pipe Adapter onto the Home Mount.



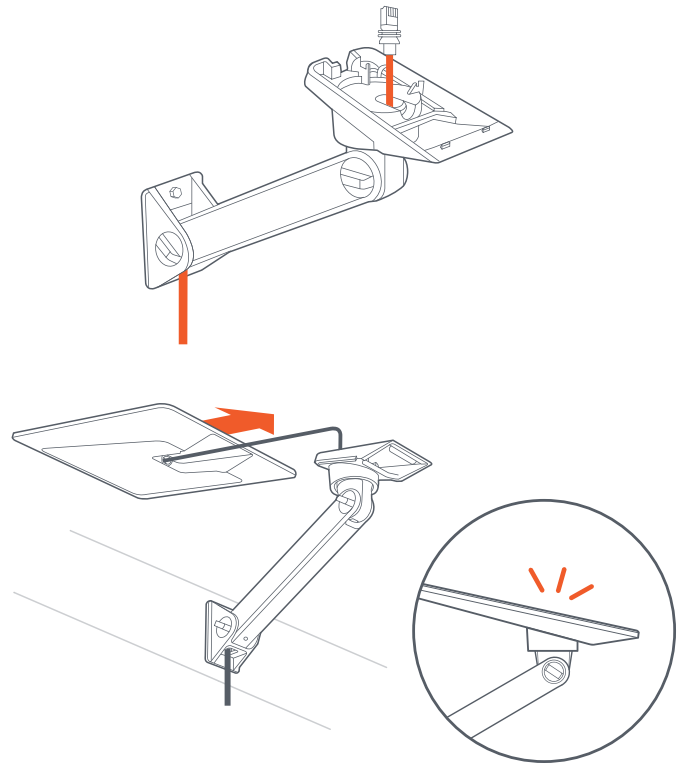

Install Starlink

Plug the connector of the Starlink Cable into your Starlink with the cable locking feature facing up. Ensure the plug is fully inserted such that the plug face is flush with the surface.

Slide your Starlink onto the Home Mount until it clicks in place.

Ensure all the cables are properly installed, then plug in the Power Cable to turn on your Starlink.

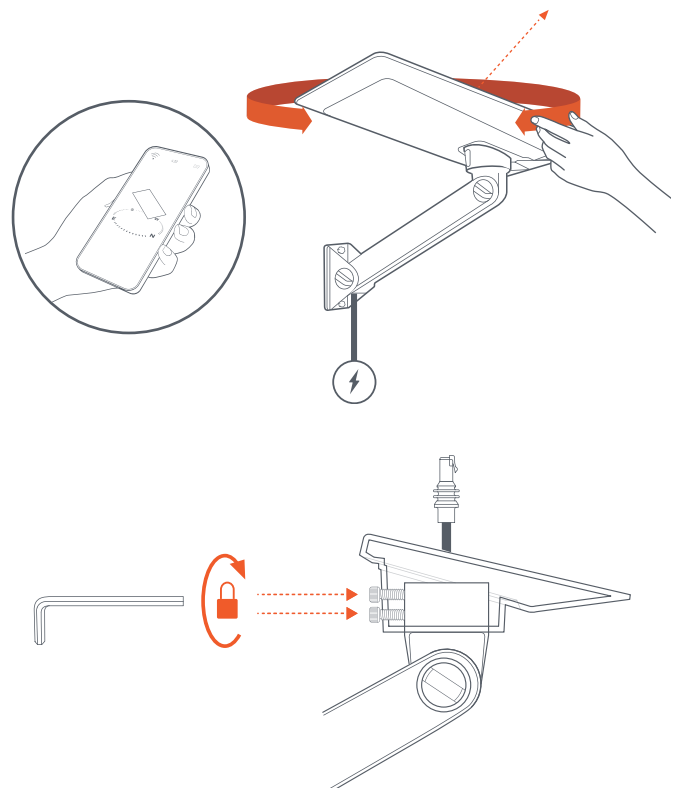


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Align & Secure

Use the Starlink App to step through the setup flow and get online. Once online, the Starlink App will alert you if any adjustments are needed to the orientation of your Starlink. Rotate your Starlink as needed to match the alignment shown in the Starlink App.

Next, use the Hex Key to install the two short Securing Bolts that were included with your Home Mount. Tighten the bolts to lock your Starlink in place.



Installation Conditions

⚠ **CAUTION!** If you are uncomfortable with any part of the installation process, do not attempt - contact a professional to install your Starlink. Starlink is not responsible for injury or damage to property caused by the installation process.

Kit Installation for Use on Moving Vehicles.

⚠ **CAUTION!** Take extra care if installing a Starlink for being used on a moving vehicle or vessel. Ensure that the mount is installed firmly on a structurally sound, horizontal surface away from other equipment to give your Starlink a clear view of the sky. Equipment falling off the vehicle due to poor installation practices can cause serious accidents resulting in bodily injury, do not mount the Starlink on any vehicle or vessel if the mount structure is not stable, or if it cannot be properly secured as described in this guide. Ensure the installation on vehicle or vessel is compliant with local Department of Transportation or maritime regulations.

⚠ **CAUTION!** Mounts are not designed for high winds, hurricane or tornado wind loads. Tethering should be used in all cases to prevent failure in an unexpected wind event. See installation instructions before connecting this equipment to the input supply.

⚠ **CAUTION!** To avoid personal injury and/or damage to the property when drilling, take caution and follow basic safety procedures, including:

- Wear appropriate eye, hand, and face protection.
- Avoid studs, electrical wiring, and water lines when drilling. Drilling into any of these can lead to fire, shock, injury, or death.
- Drill at a slight downward angle from the home interior to the home exterior and thoroughly apply sealant. Improper drilling and sealing may lead to water and/or bug intrusion and/or damage.
